For submission and reviewing, the Editorial Manager of JLMN is used. The submission is already possible.

1. Preparation of your manuscript

2. Submission of your manuscript

The submission procedure is almost the same as that for general contribution. Use the Editorial Manager of JLMN, and follow the usual procedure of submission.
